As the 2024 nominating cycle draws closer, the field of Republican presidential candidates is consolidating.

- Former Vice President Mike Pence <u>announced suspending his campaign</u> Saturday at the Republican Jewish Coalition Conference in Las Vegas, Nevada, asking GOP voters to choose a "Republican standard-bearer" in 2024.
- Larry Elder, conservative talk radio host and former California gubernatorial candidate, endorsed former President Donald Trump as he exited the race Thursday, calling for the GOP to unite behind Trump to defeat President Joe Biden in the general election.
- Michigan businessman Perry Johnson <u>also endorsed Trump</u>, three days after suspending his own presidential campaign while criticizing the Republican National Committee's rules for debate participation.

Republican presidential candidates will debate next in Miami, Florida on Nov. 8. North Dakota Gov. Doug Burgum and former Arkansas Gov. Asa Hutchinson have not yet met the polling or donor thresholds required by the RNC to participate.

Trump, who skipped the first two debates, will also not join the stage next week. Instead, Trump plans to host a rally in Hialeah, Florida.

Trump's lead over his rivals for the 2024 Iowa caucuses grew in the Des Moines Register/NBC News/Mediacom Iowa Poll published Monday, while former U.N. Ambassador Nikki Haley rose to tie with Florida Gov. Ron DeSantis for second place.

The poll found 43% of likely Republican caucusgoers plan to choose Trump as their first choice in the caucuses, up from 42% in the August Iowa Poll. While DeSantis kept hold of his second place spot, his position as the leading alternative to the former president flagged between the two polls. From August to October, DeSantis fell from 19% to 16% of respondents who picked him as their first choice as Haley made a 10-percentage-point leap in the same category, matching DeSantis at 16% in the latest poll. | Iowa Capital Dispatch

<u>As Biden skips New Hampshire primary, Democrats plan a write-in campaign anyway</u>

If a voter writes "Biden" in the write-in portion of the New Hampshire Democratic Party presidential primary ballot this January, it will likely count as a vote for President Joe Biden, Secretary of State Dave Scanlan says.

But if a voter simply writes "Joe"? That depends on if there are any other Joes on the ballot, Scanlan said at a press conference. The questions could soon become important. 
